

#### **UPCOMING FIELDWORK IN YOUR AREA**

Puget Sound Energy is currently in the process of developing and evaluating long-term solutions for the West Sound's power needs. As part of this planning, we will be conducting environmental fieldwork in and around locations where system improvements could be made. We've identified your property as a site where we may need to conduct fieldwork.

### What you can expect

**WHO:** Crews from PSE's contractor, WSP.

**WHAT:** Surveying critical areas (e.g., wetlands, streams, fish and wildlife habitats).

- Crews may cut tall brush to be able to safely access the survey areas.
  They will dig small holes by hand and backfill them immediately after assessment.
- Crews may place ribbons or pin flags in surveyed areas.

**WHEN:** Four weeks, beginning in mid-April. Typical work hours are Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m.

**WHERE:** PSE's existing transmission easement corridor (see map on reverse). Crews will not access private property outside of PSE's existing easements.
